

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BOERNE ZONING NO. 2007-64, CAPTIONED, "ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS", DATED DECEMBER 18, 2007, BY AMENDING ARTICLE 3, SECTION 13, PERMANENT ZONING OF .972 ACRE LOCATED AT 629 W. SAN ANTONIO AVENUE (KAD 26725) FROM R-A, SINGLE FAMILY RURAL RESIDENTIAL-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO R-1, MEDIUM DENSITY SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; CONTAINING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Boerne has complied with all requirements of notice of public hearing as required by the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Boerne; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required to permanently zone properties that have been annexed into the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide harmony between existing zoning districts and proposed land uses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Zoning Map by rezoning .972 acre located at 629 W. San Antonio Avenue (KAD 26725) From R-A, Single Family Rural Residential – Agricultural District to R-1, Medium Density Single-Family Residential District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOERNE, TEXAS:


Section 1.

That Article 3, Section 13, of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Boerne, Texas, and particularly the Zoning Map of the City of Boerne, is amended by rezoning the following described tracts of land:

629 W. San Antonio Avenue (KAD 26725) From R-A, Single Family Rural Residential – Agricultural District to R-1, Medium Density Single-Family Residential District.

Section 2.

That the Zoning Maps of the City of Boerne be amended to indicate the previously described change.



Section 3.

That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Boerne not herein amended or repealed shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4.

That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict.

Section 5.

That if any provisions of this ordinance shall be held void or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not held void or unconstitutional shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6.

This ordinance will take effect upon the second and final reading of same.
