Boerne city manager Ron Bowman was recently presented with the Gary Brown City Services Award from the Texas Public Power Association.

This award recognizes outstanding leadership and dedication by a municipal official and member utility. Boerne Utilities is locally owned and managed, with rates and policies set by the city council. Municipal utility revenues stay in our community and help fund some of our local services such as public safety, parks and the library.

A MATTER OF FACT:

Texas state law governs firearms and because it does not prohibit the carrying of a long gun (shotgun/rifle) in a public place; a person is generally allowed to carry those weapons in public places in the state of Texas.

Stage 1 water conservation rules are in effect for Boerne Water Utility customers

Spring rains were great, but now the summer heat has set in and our lawns and gardens are getting mighty thirsty. Just remember that if you are a Boerne Water Utility customer, you are required to follow the Stage 1 "mandatory" water conservation rules. Most lawns in our area only need about 1" of water per week, so over-watering is just not necessary, plus it costs you extra money!

Landscape watering with sprinklers or irrigation systems allowed only
7:00 pm - 11:00 am
2 days per week according to street address (1 weekday & 1 weekend day)

Hand watering with hose or bucket allowed anytime.

School Zones are in effect beginning Monday, August 22

Back to school rules at the Patrick Heath Public Library

Children ages 10 and under are not allowed on library grounds after school without a parent or guardian at least 16 years of age being present. However, during library programming; children 8 years of age and older may attend scheduled library programs without a responsible adult. Prompt pickup at the end of programs is appreciated.

Parents, should be aware that there is no supervision at all on the outside of the building; the woods behind the library are not a safe spot for children and teens to hang out.

All teens age 11 and older will be asked to sign a "behavior pledge" agreeing to abide by library rules.


